- Violation notices will be sent for non-compliant carports, yard cleanup, peeling paint, exterior repairs.
- Grass must be kept mowed less than 8 inches in height. Do not mow or blow grass into street; all grass debris must be removed from street.
- Fence lines must be grass and weed free.
- Store trash and recycling cans behind the front of house.

Just to let everyone know, our FLOCK cameras are up and running. Some of you may have noticed them in select places near our roadways and wondered what they are for or what they do? First off, these cameras are not recording your homes or used in any way that would violate your privacy. They are strictly for reading license plates and we will receive alerts within seconds for things like stolen autos, stolen license plates, etc. The idea is to try and keep crime out of Edmundson which in turn offers a better quality of life while living in our great little city. If you happen to have any further questions or concerns, please feel free to contact me or Captain Venneman and we would be more than happy to answer them.

There is still MONEY available to qualifying home owners. Does your home need repairs? Do you have Code Violations? Why not take advantage of the St. Louis County Home Improvement Program?

St. Louis County provides 5-year forgivable home improvement loans to low- and moderate-income homeowners to make necessary improvements to their homes. These loans are limited to a maximum of \$5,000 and are available to Edmundson residents.

Interested residents should call (314) 615-8232 to make an application. This program is only available to owner-occupants and participants must be current on their real estate taxes.

Eligible Repairs funded by the Home Improvement Program include:

- Roof Replacement
- Concrete and Masonry Repair/Replacement
- Tree Removal
- Hand Rail Installation
- Major Electrical Repairs
- Major Plumbing Repair/Replacement
- Furnace and Air Conditioner Replacement
- Major Waterproofing
- Insulation
